- ◆Nearby attraction: Sannai-Maruyama ruins
In the Special Historical Site of Sannai Maruyama are the ruins of Japan's largest Jomon village.
Ongoing excavations continue to reveal information on the environment, lifestyle, and conditions of the village during that time. The ruins are open all year round, so you can freely drop by to learn more. (20 minutes by car from JR Aomori Station)
- ◆Notes: We make use of a booking priority system. You will need to arrange for an international exchange student guide beforehand, but you may choose not to avail of this service.
